



Polonsky Prizes for Creativity and Originality in the Humanistic Disciplines 2014

The Authority for Research and Development and the Faculty of Humanities are pleased to announce the **Polonsky Prizes for Creativity and Originality in the Humanistic Disciplines** for the year 2014.

The Polonsky Prizes were initiated in 2005 by Dr. Leonard Polonsky, a prominent member of the British Friends of The Hebrew University, who has very generously set up this award to provide support for research in the Humanities.

The prizes are intended for nominees belonging to the Hebrew University community, in the following three Categories:

- A. Researchers (for a book or article)
- B. Post-Doctoral researchers (for their dissertation)
- C. PhD or M.A. students (for M.A. thesis or published article)

The prizes will be awarded for one academic work: a book, article, dissertation or thesis, in any field of the Humanities, published **within the last five years** (in the case of dissertations or thesis, accepted in the last five years).

Up to four prizes – two researcher prizes, one post-doctorate and one student prize – will be awarded, in person only, at the ceremony at the University Board of Governors annual meeting, to be held in June 2014. Prizes shall range from \$2,000-5,000 for PhD and M.A. students and \$6,000-10,000 for researchers and post-doctoral researchers.

Both self-nominations and nominations of colleagues and students may be submitted. The works submitted will be judged for creativity and originality.

Final Submission Date: Wednesday, March 12, 2014

Please note that the submission process has changed as follows:

- Submission, evaluation and fund distribution procedures will be handled by the Faculty of Humanities.
- All arrangements for winners, regarding the award ceremony at the Board of Governors meeting, will be handled by the office of Vice President for Research and Development at The Authority for Research and Development.

Nominations should be submitted as follows:

Category A: Researchers

- A. 2 hard copies of the work itself (book, paper, dissertation, thesis)
- B. An electronic copy of the following, **in this order, as 1 PDF file**, by e-mail:
 - 1. The Application Form attached below
 - 2. An abstract of 1-2 pages, in English **and** in Hebrew, explaining the creativity and originality of the work
 - 3. Two letters of recommendation from scholars, in English **or** Hebrew, from within or outside The Hebrew University
- C. A current photograph of the nominee (in jpeg format, in high quality)
- D. 2-3 colorful illustrations or photos reflecting your research (in jpeg format, in high quality)

Category B & C: Post-Doctoral researchers, PhD and M.A. students:

- A. 2 CDs of the work itself (in case of an article, 2 hard copies as well).
- B. An electronic copy of the following, **in this order, as 1 PDF file**, by e-mail:
 - 1. The Application Form attached below
 - 2. An abstract of 1-2 pages, in English **and** in Hebrew, explaining the creativity and originality of the work
 - 3. Two letters of recommendation from scholars, in English **or** Hebrew, from within or outside The Hebrew University
 - 4. **Post-doctoral researchers ONLY:** the evaluations of the dissertation
- C. A current photograph of the nominee (in jpeg format, in high quality)
- D. 2-3 colorful illustrations or photos reflecting your research (in jpeg format, high quality)
