Group Research Grants 2017/8

The Center for German Studies invites members of the Faculties of Social Sciences, Humanities and Law to apply for seed money to build research groups on any topic related to



Germany after 1945 | Germany & the EU | Germany & Israel

Priority will be given to research proposals focusing on Memory and the City.

Eligibility criteria:

- originality
- degree of cooperation among the three faculties
- integration of graduate students (MA, PhD, Post-doctoral)
- partnership with colleague(s) from German universities
- chances to get external funding in the future

Conditions:

- Research groups' activity will receive support up to \$10,000 per year for a period that will not exceed two years.
- The grant may be used for research and travel scholarships for the graduate students and support for the organization of meetings, workshops, symposia, lecture series, according to the needs and profile of the elected project. The grant will not cover administration expenses.
- A draft application to an external fund, as well as yearly and final academic and financial reports, have to be submitted to the Center for German Studies at the end of each calendar year.
- The research grant receivers will state the support of the Center for German Studies in every publication or activity resulting from this project.

The application should contain the following documents, in the following order:

1. Application form (can be downloaded from <http://ef.huji.ac.il/book/ef-calls>)
2. A description of the research topic and the expected results (max. 2 pages)
3. A description of the state of research (max. 2 pages), exemplified by a short bibliographical list
4. A list of colleagues and graduate students to participate in the research project, including their CVs and list of relevant publications
5. Evidence of cooperation with at least one German colleague
6. A list of planned activities, approximated timetable and estimated costs involved in conducting research during 2017
7. A list of other research grants received for this project
