

UPDATE: 09.10.2020

Visas and Entry Permits for Incoming International Students, Post Docs and Researchers

The Government of Israel has announced it will renew the issuing of entry permits for international students, following the lockdown, and entry into Israel will be possible as of 18.10.2020.

In light of this, we would like to update you regarding the current [regulations](#) for international students and researchers entering Israel during the lockdown.

1. **Students and Post Docs who have already received a visa are requested to notify and send a copy of their visa to the International Office by Sunday 11/10/2020 08:00 Israel (unless already submitted via our system).**
2. Students who have not yet received a visa and entry permit are advised to contact their local embassy/consulate as of 13.10.2020 to submit an application promptly. Issued entry permits will be valid only as of 18.10.2020.

Students who encounter any bureaucratic challenges at embassies/consulates are requested to update the International Office promptly and we will try to assist.

We recommend not to book flights before you receive the visa and entry permit.

3. Students are requested to follow the updates of their local embassy/consulate and the university announcements.
4. **We want to emphasize again that entry into Israel will not be permitted without a special entry permit delivered by your embassy/consulate or Immigration Authority.**
5. All international incoming students and researchers are requested to register [HERE](#), unless you already have done so, in order to support them with their arrival preparations.

We understand that these are times of uncertainty. However, please be reassured that our team is fully dedicated to assist you and to ensure smooth arrival to Israel, as soon as the circumstances will allow it.
